



Directions to The Children's Inn at NIH

Driving Directions

From Baltimore and All Points North of Washington, DC

- Take I-95 south toward Washington, DC. At I-495 (Capital Beltway), go west toward Silver Spring/Bethesda
- Take Exit 34 (MD-355/Wisconsin Avenue/Rockville Pike) and go south toward Washington/Bethesda
- Turn right at the NIH Gateway Drive and **proceed to the visitor security checkpoint**
- Once on campus, take a right onto Center Drive. Continue through campus and take a right on West Drive. The Inn is immediately on the left.

OR

- Take I-270 south toward Washington
- When I-270 splits, take the left spur toward College Park/Silver Spring
- Take the MD-355 S/Bethesda exit on the left and merge onto Rockville Pike/MD-355 S
- Turn right at the NIH Gateway Drive and **proceed to the visitor security checkpoint**
- Once on campus, take a right onto Center Drive. Continue through campus and take a right on West Drive. The Inn is immediately on the left

From Virginia and All Points South of Washington, DC

- Take I-95 north toward Washington, DC
- Keep right via Exit 170A-B toward I-395 N/Washington/I-495 N/Tysons Corner
- Take Exit 170B and merge onto I-495 N/Capital Beltway toward Tysons Corner (you will cross into Maryland and head north toward Silver Spring/Bethesda)
- From the Beltway (I-495), take Exit 34, which is MD-355/Wisconsin Avenue/Rockville Pike and go south toward Washington/Bethesda

- Turn right at NIH Gateway Drive and **proceed to the visitor security checkpoint**. Once on campus, take a right onto Center Drive. Continue through campus and take a right on West Drive. The Inn is immediately on the left

Taking the Metro

On the Metro (subway system), take the Red Line to the Medical Center stop. At the top of the escalator proceed to the **Gateway Visitors Center**.

Driving Directions from the Three Area Airports

Baltimore/Washington Thurgood Marshall International Airport (BWI) 34.2 mi

1. Take the Airport exit (I-195 W) 4.4 mi
2. Take exit 4B to merge onto I-95 S toward Washington 19.6 mi
3. Take exit 27 to merge onto Capital Beltway/I-495 W toward Silver Spring 7.8 mi
4. Take exit 34, MD-355 toward Bethesda/Rockville 0.3 mi
5. Merge onto MD-355 N/Rockville Pike 259 ft
6. Slight right at Grosvenor Ln (signs for MD-355, Bethesda/Washington) 0.1 mi
7. Very quickly, sharp left at sign for MD-355 S. You are now on Rockville Pike 1.7 mi
8. Turn right at NIH Gateway Drive and **proceed to the visitor security checkpoint**

Dulles International Airport (IAD) 25.2 mi

1. Take the exit towards Washington (Dulles Airport Access Rd)
2. Continue on Dulles Airport Access Rd (Parallel to Dulles Toll Road Rt. 267) 2.1 mi
3. Take the exit toward I-495 (exit 18-19/Rt. 123/Baltimore/Richmond) 0.2 mi
4. Merge onto Rt. 267 E (the end of the Dulles Toll Road) 0.9 mi
5. Take exit 18 onto Capital Beltway/I-495 N toward Baltimore 9.9 mi
6. Take exit 34 onto MD-355 S/Rockville Pike toward Wisconsin Ave/Bethesda 1.6 mi
7. Turn right at NIH Gateway Drive and **proceed to the visitor security checkpoint**

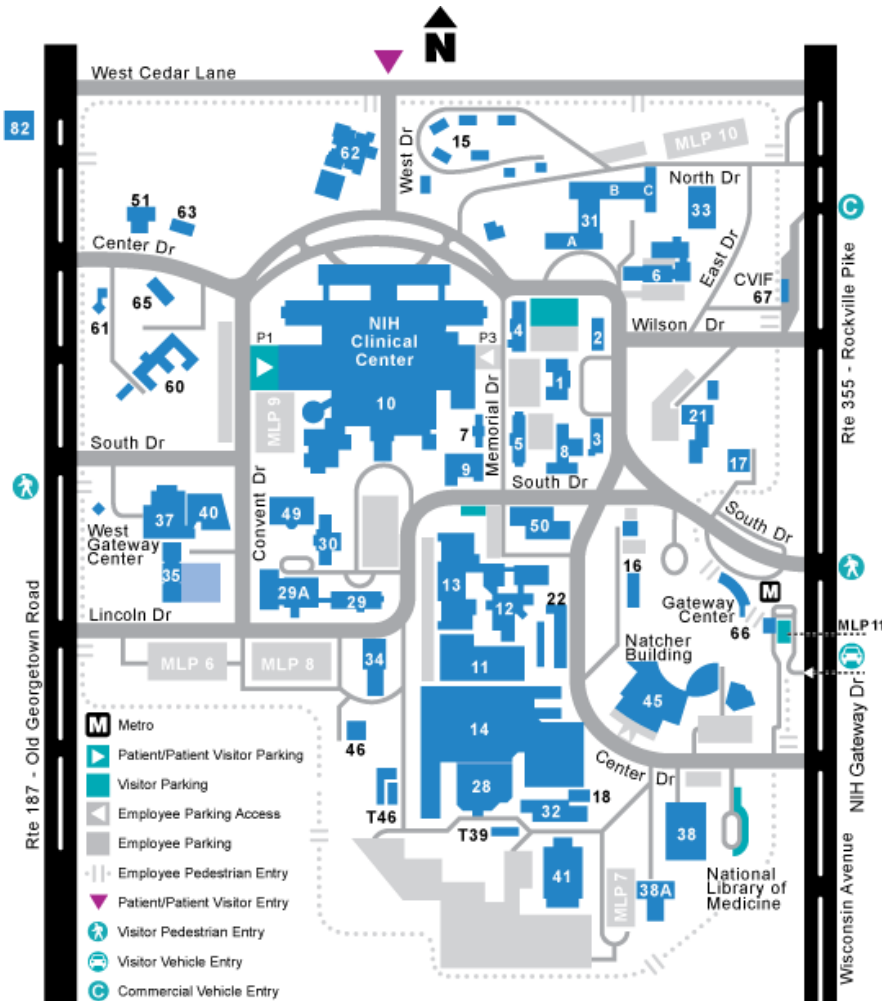
Washington/Reagan National Airport 21.2 mi

1. Head northeast and take a slight left (signs for B C/Arrivals-Bag Claim)
2. Take the ramp to George Washington Memorial Pkwy N (GW Pkwy N) 335 ft
3. Keep right at the fork, follow signs for GW Pkwy N, merge onto GW Pkwy N 11.8 mi
4. Take the exit North to Maryland (merging onto Capital Beltway/I-495 N) 6.8 mi
5. Take exit 34 onto MD-355 S/Rockville Pike toward Wisconsin Ave/Bethesda 1.6 mi
6. Turn right at the NIH Gateway Drive and **proceed to the visitor security checkpoint**

Patient and Patient Visitor Parking:

Clinical Center — P1 Entrance
Parking Ticket Validation Required
Monday — Friday, 7am - 7pm

Patient & Patient Visitor Parking
Validation:
B1 Lobby at Hospitality Desk

No validation required weeknights
after 7pm, weekends & holidays

Valet Parking Service:
Available at the Clinical Center
Main Entrance

Monday — Friday
7am – 7pm
Ticket validation required

Valet Parking Validation:
North Lobby at Hospitality Desk
7am - 7pm

Unclaimed vehicles after 7pm will
be parked in the P-1 garage or
Lot 10E. Keys will be transferred
to the CRC/Bldg. 10 Admissions
desk.

**Patient and Patient Visitor
Extended Access Pass:**
You can request an optional,
extended visitor Photo ID and
Campus Access Pass to expedite
your campus and building entry.
Visit the Clinical Center
Admissions Desk or see your
patient care coordinator for these
timesaving services.

General Visitor Parking Information:

Visitors (*other than patients*) parking
at the **Gateway Parking Garage
(MLP-11)** and in designated visitor
parking lot:

Monday — Friday, 7am – 7pm:
\$2.00 per hour for the first three
hours \$12.00 for the entire day

Metered parking lots:
Monday — Friday, 7am – 7pm
\$2 per hour

The NIH has implemented security
measures to help ensure the safety of
our patients, employees, guests and
facilities. All visitors must enter
through the NIH Gateway Center at
Metro or the West Gateway Visitor
Center. You will be asked to submit to
a vehicle or personal inspection.

Visitors over 15 years of age must
provide a form of government-issued
ID such as a driver's license or
passport. Visitors under 16 years of
age must be accompanied by an
adult.

Vehicle Inspections – All vehicles
and their contents will be inspected
upon entering the campus.
Additionally, all vehicles entering
certain parking areas will be
inspected, regardless of any prior
inspection. Drivers will be required to
present their driver's license and may
be asked to open the trunk and hood.
If you are physically unable to
perform this function, please inform
the inspector and they will assist you.

Vehicle inspection may consist of any
combination of the following:
Detection Dogs Teams (K-9),
Electronic Detection Devices and
Manual Inspection.

After inspection, you will be issued a
vehicle inspection pass. It must be
displayed on your vehicle's
dashboard while you are on campus.
The inspection pass is not a "parking
permit." It only grants your vehicle
access to enter the campus. You can
only park in designated parking
areas. (See campus map)

Personal Inspections – All visitors
should be prepared to submit to a
personal inspection prior to entering
the campus. These inspections may
be conducted with a handheld
monitoring device, a metal detector
and by visible inspection.
Additionally, your personal
belongings may be inspected and
passed through an x-ray machine.

Firearms, explosives, archery
equipment, dangerous weapons,
knives with blades over 2 1/2 inches,
alcoholic beverages and open
containers of alcohol are examples of
prohibited items on the NIH campus.

***Visitor passes must be
prominently displayed at all
times while on the NIH campus.***
